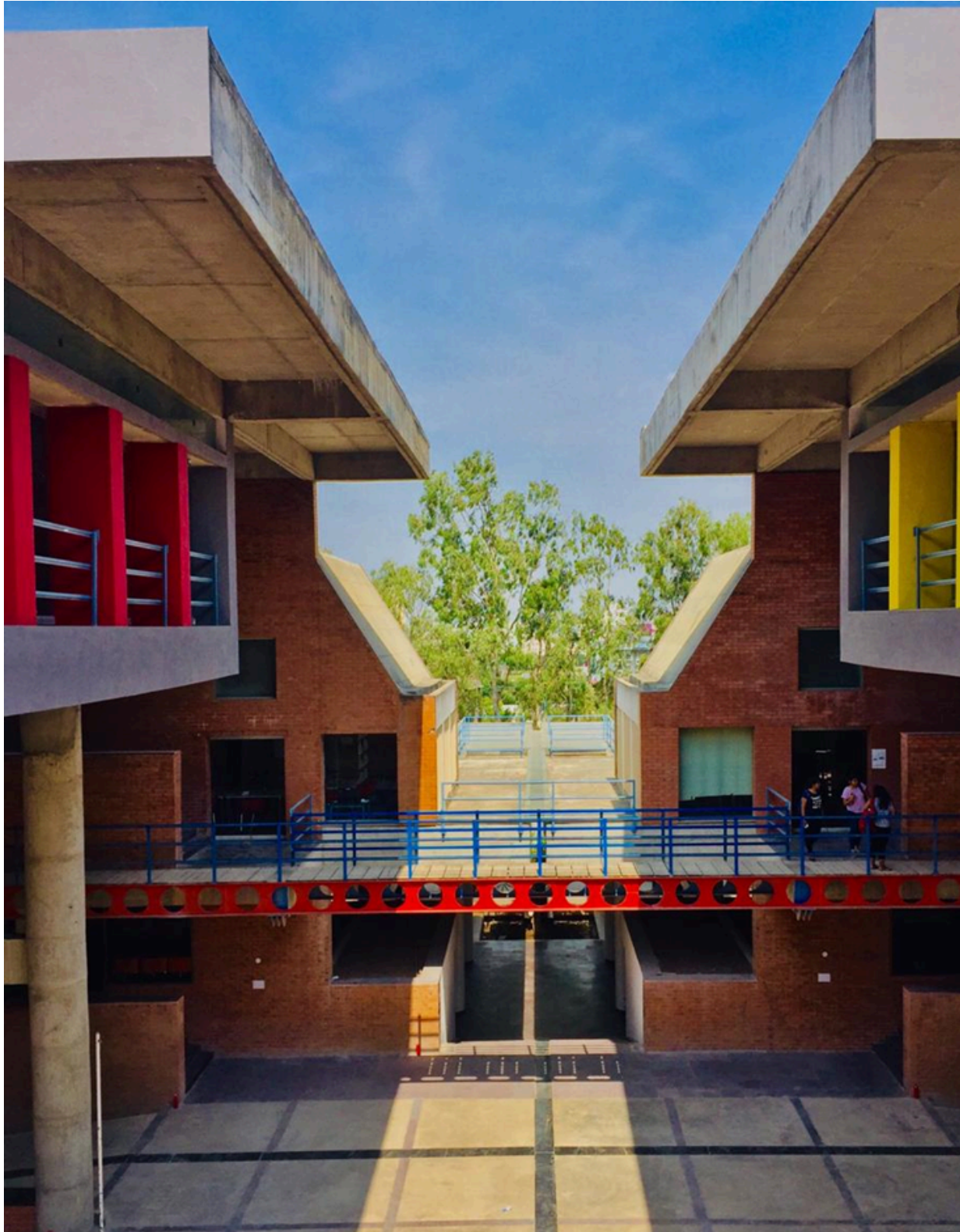

Technical Writing for Architectural Research:

This session focused on the essentials of technical writing in the context of architectural research. Students learned how to structure their research papers, articulate their findings clearly, and present their arguments effectively. Emphasis was placed on clarity, precision, and adherence to academic standards, ensuring that architectural research communicates its insights in a professional and comprehensible manner.

Finalizing Research Topic:

In this session, students explored strategies for refining their research topics. The lecture covered how to narrow down broad ideas into specific, researchable questions. Key considerations included relevance, feasibility, and the potential impact on the field of



architecture. Students were guided through a process of aligning their interests with gaps in existing research to finalize a compelling and manageable research topic.

Exploring Mendeley as a Tool for Literature Review in Research:

This session introduced Mendeley, a reference management tool, as a resource for conducting literature reviews. Students learned how to use Mendeley to organize research papers, annotate documents, and generate citations. The focus was on leveraging Mendeley's features to streamline the literature review process, enhance organization, and ensure accurate referencing.

How to do Literature Review for Architectural Research:

The session provided a comprehensive overview of the literature review process. Students were taught how to identify relevant sources, evaluate the quality of research, and synthesize findings from various studies. The lecture emphasized the importance of critically engaging with existing literature to build a solid foundation for their own research.

Research Methodology:

Students explored various research methods, including qualitative and quantitative techniques, case studies, and experimental designs. The focus was on selecting appropriate methodologies to address specific research questions and ensuring that the chosen methods align with the objectives of their architectural research.
